"Small Town USA"

The Pontotoc County Bodock Association in conjunction with the Tupelo Bicycle Club presents the 5th annual Pontotoc "Tour de Bodock," a metric century bicycle road ride. The ride will be held Saturday, August 6, 2011, (rain or shine) at 8 am. Registration begins at 7 am. The ride will take you through rolling hills south and west of Pontotoc and through Amish Community. The ride is held under a USA Cycling Event Permit. Two routes will be available- a 62+ mile metric century and a 37 mile ride. These routes will take you on surfaces ranging from well-paved roads with ample shoulders to lightly-traveled tar and chip county roads.

This is a tour and not a race. Plan to ride at a rate appropriate to your training and road conditions. There are some challenging hills on each route, so please be sure your bike is in good working order. There will be a support vehicle monitoring the routes in case assistance is needed. Riders must wear helmets.

Services: Rest and refreshment stops will be provided along the route. Sag support and showers will be provided until 1:00 pm. Shower facilities will be provided at the Pontotoc Wellness Center beside the Pontotoc High School Track and Field Parking Lot. Bring your own soap and towel.

Be sure to check out the arts, crafts, and entertainment in downtown Pontotoc for the rest of the Bodock Festival.

Directions: The ride begins and ends at the Pontotoc High School Track and Field Parking Lot on Reynolds Street. Registration will be held at the High School parking lot as well. To reach Pontotoc:

1. From Oxford, take Hwy 278 east about 30 miles, exit Hwy 15 (Wal-Mart). Turn left on Oxford Street and go to next red light (Main/Oxford St.) and turn right. Go past High School on right and turn right at the first stop sign (Reynolds St). Parking lot is on the right about 1/10th mile.
2. From Tupelo North, take Hwy 78 to Sherman exit and take Hwy 9 to Pontotoc. Go through red light and pass High School on right. Turn right at first stop sign (Reynolds St). Parking lot on right about 1/10th mile.
3. From Tupelo Central or South, take Hwy 278 to Pontotoc about 15 miles, exit Hwy 9. Turn left onto Hwy 9 to Pontotoc. Go through red light and pass High School on right. Turn right at first stop sign (Reynolds St). Parking lot is on the right about 1/10th mile.

To assure you will receive a t-shirt, registration must be returned as soon as possible.
